



The Co-op's Technical Scholarship Rules

PURPOSE:

The purpose of our scholarship competition is to support our students who choose to further their education and will pursue Associate Degrees / Technical or Trade School certificates.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

- First prize: \$2,500
- Second prize: \$2,000
- Third prize: \$1,500

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The following provisions govern the eligibility of applicants for the co-op's technical scholarship:

1. Applicants must be high school seniors enrolling in an Associates Degree program / Technical or Trade School program.
2. Applicants must be a son, daughter, or legal ward of a Logan County Electric Cooperative residential member living on our lines and receiving service at the time of competition.
3. Applicants must have cumulative grade point averages of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent standing on nontraditional scales. Winners must provide proof of enrollment in an accredited college / technical or trade school to claim their scholarship.
4. Applications for our competition must be typed and submitted on the forms provided by the co-op. **Application forms must be returned to the co-op office by Monday, March 11, 2024.** Application information must be confined to the official nomination form. .
5. Applicants who have received "full-ride" scholarships (tuition, room, board, and books) to the schools of their choice are not eligible for this competition.
6. All scholarships must be accepted in the first academic year. However, an extension of one year may be granted for just cause in the judgment of the co-op's general manager. If applicant cannot fulfill enrollment obligation under this program, awards are forfeited.
